OUR WATER MISSION

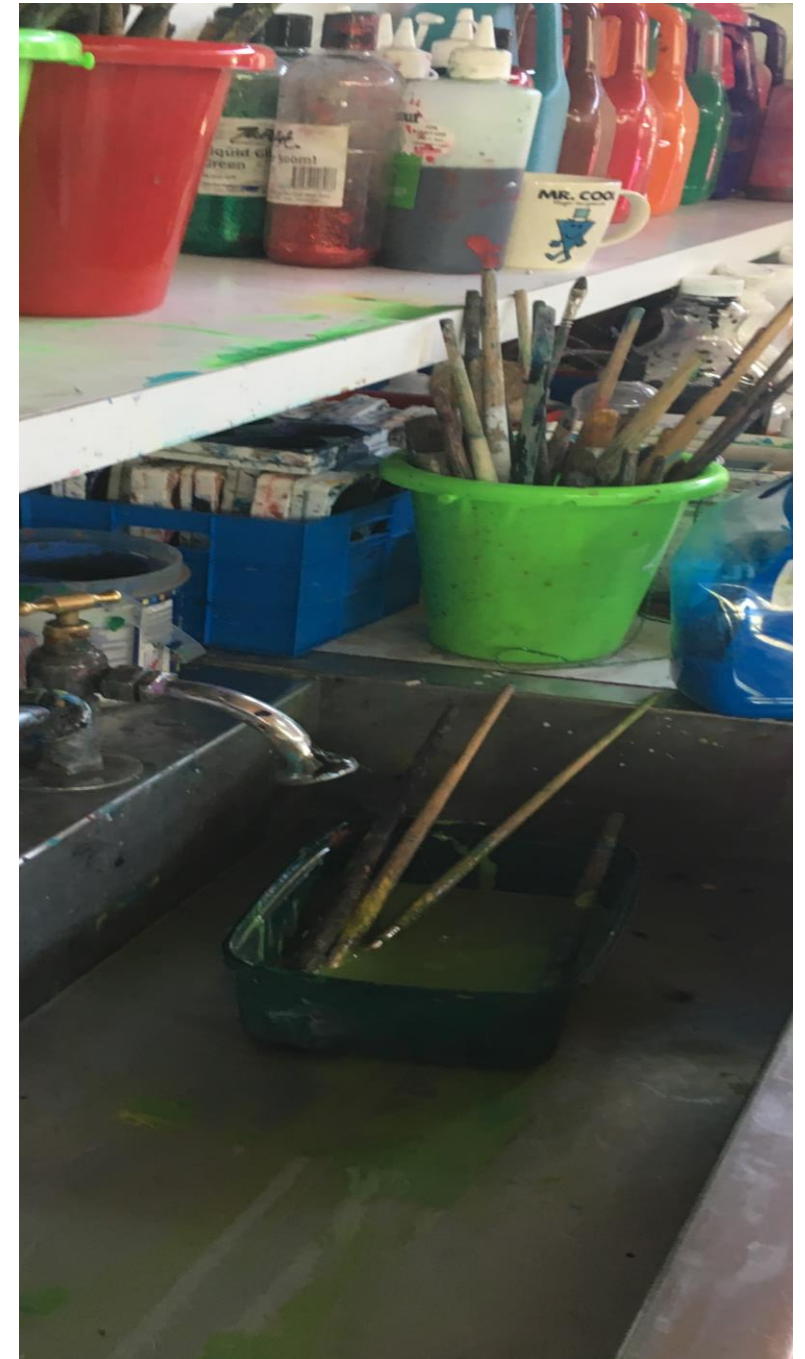
- Our mission since the last Big Green Schools Conference was to find ways that we can save and conserve water around our school.



- Here are some of the ways we were able to do this...

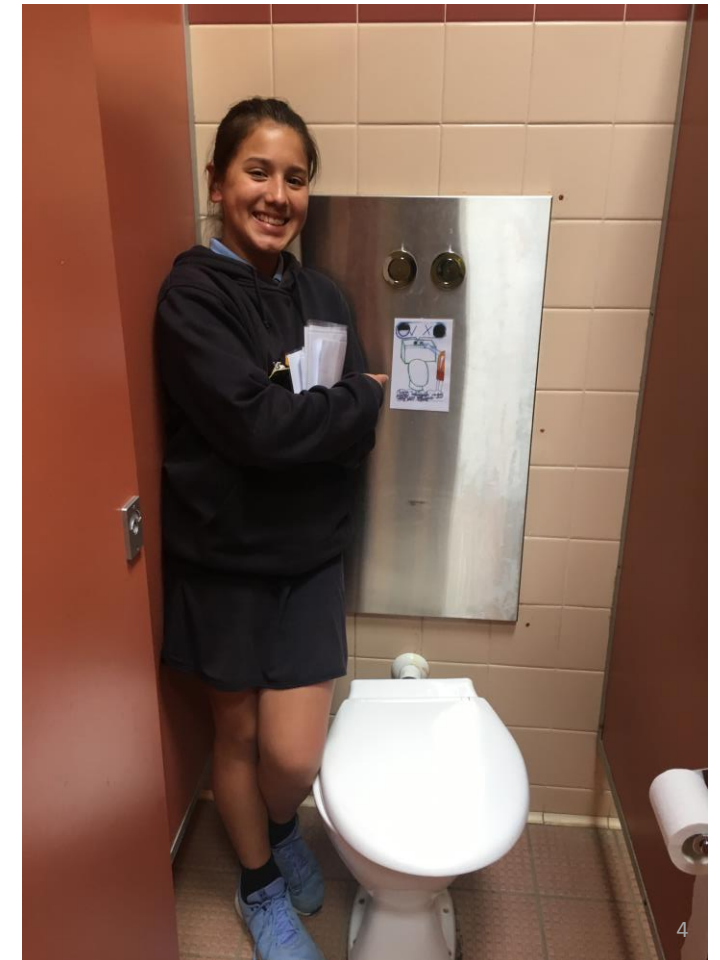
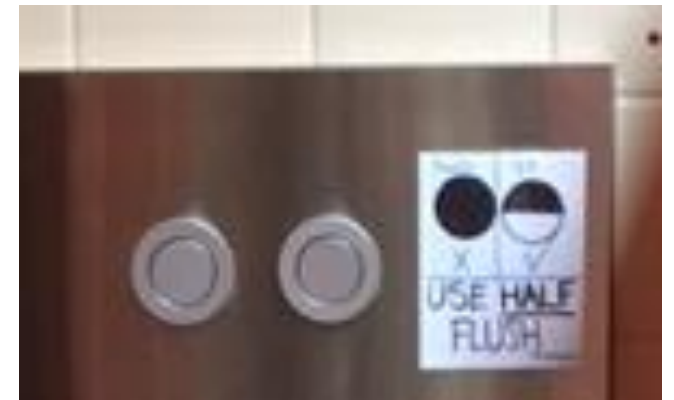


**BUCKETS UNDER OUR DRINKING TAPS,
